# **Unjustified Impediments to an Appeal Hearing**

The New Jersey Judiciary has made their position crystal clear: I WILL NEVER RECEIVE MY RIGHT TO A FAIR, LEGAL PROCESS NOR MY RIGHT TO A TRIAL IN FRONT OF A JURY OF MY PEERS. This has been evidenced repeatedly over the past decade. It has been further evidenced over the past few months.

- In 2010 I told the Defendants that the mortgage and foreclosure were fraudulent and
  there was no mortgage agreement with Fremont on file with Essex County. They
  reversed the foreclosure and later filed a fraudulent mortgage agreement with the State
  of New Jersey.
- In 2014, I filed proof that the mortgage and second foreclosure was fraudulent. The Defendants resorted to legal fraud and threats in an effort to silence me.
- In 2019, I filed the same evidence as well as a report by a leading forgery expert that corroborated my evidence. The NJ Judiciary quadrupled down in their depraved 10year effort to deny me due process.

The NJ Judiciary has wiped out my funds and ability to borrow, but their actions **STRENGTHEN MY RESOLVE TO EXPOSE AND STOP MASSIVE AND SYSTEMIC FRAUD**.

Just since April 2019, certain employees in the NJ Judiciary have:

• Returned my Appeal Filing – <i>twice</i>	I reviewed procedures thoroughly before filing my appeal. My previous appeal was accepted in 2016. I also clarified instructions and processes with multiple NJ employees each time before sending my appeal.  I submitted 4 copies, one in spiral binding, over 3,600 pages. They were neat and clearly separated 1. Less than 30% of my submission was returned and it was in total disarray. The document in spiral binding was <b>NOT returned</b> .
Denied my Fee Waiver	My fee waiver was previously granted by another NJ Judge when my <i>disposable income was greater than it is now.</i> The recent US District Court order <sup>2</sup> granted my leave to appeal " <i>in forma pauperis</i> ". A new Judge was to have decided my fee waiver for the Appeal.
Delayed Processing	I confirmed with multiple NJ employees that my submission had been received. It was difficult to find, once my box was in a storeroom without any markings. <i>The label had been removed</i> .  I had to resend the cover documents and make multiple calls to ensure that both packages were taken to the Appeals Office. Please note that some employees were quite courteous and responsive.
Bolstered Efforts to Exhaust My Funds	I used third party services to print, assemble, package and ship documents <sup>3</sup> . I hand delivered documents to the NJ Court in May. The Court repeatedly required that I duplicate expenses. <sup>4</sup>

The attorney for the Plaintiffs in my foreclosure (NJ Case F-0000839-13), who also represented all Defendants in my Federal Case, issued a directive during the May hearing. Mr. Seiden made it clear that he did not want to see a lot of documents from me (as I had filed in the past). The NJ Judiciary obeyed.

Mr. Seiden closed his statements in the hearing by telling Judge Orsen what he intended to do. There are many obvious benefits that may have been gained by the people who followed Mr. Seiden's command.

This is an important step in exposing and eradicating the obvious and blatant corruption that has plagued my attempts to legally expose this cornucopia of altruistic, illegal and interrelated acts. These acts continue for they are backed by travesties of justice.

The order granted my leave to appeal "in forma pauperis" for good reason. The actions of these defendants have decimated me financially. I ask that the Court accept future filings in digital files (i.e. portable document format – PDF). This will reduce the financial burden on me (Veronica Williams) as well as reduce the labor burden on the Court's staff.

With patience, I pray the Court allows me to proceed with a jury trial.
